Becky Plattner called the meeting to order at 9:01 am.

Becky Plattner asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the May 7, 2025 session. Stephanie Gooden made a motion to approve. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Becky Plattner asked for a motion to approve a payment schedule. Monte Fenner made a motion to approve. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Deputy Auditor Summer McBryar presented commission order #6658 to void and reissue check #119793 due to the vendor not receiving the payment, order #6655 in the amount of \$189,907.95 for a cash transfer of payroll, order #6656 in the amount of \$4,495.88 for CERF .7% and elective savings, order #6657 in the amount of \$21,934.91 for the April 2025 CERF collections, and order #6654 in the amount of \$33,586.42 for 941 taxes. Becky Plattner asked for a motion approve. Monte Fenner made a motion to approve the commission orders as presented. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Monte Fenner presented liquor licenses in the amount of \$3,162, which included 6 renewals and 10 caterer's licenses. Becky Plattner asked for a motion to approve. Stephanie Gooden made a motion to approve the liquor licenses as presented. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Sheriff Daniel Kirchhoff submitted a request to hire Jayleigh Perrin for a full-time position in the Jail Division. Her start date is set for May 12, 2025 and her rate of pay will be \$17.51 per hour plus a \$600 annual uniform allowance. Becky Plattner asked for a motion to approve the new hire. Stephanie Gooden made a motion to approve. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Becky Plattner presented a request to hire Brad Hinz for a full-time position as the Emergency Management Director. His start date was set for May 12, 2025. Commissioner Plattner asked for a motion to approve. Stephanie Gooden made a motion to approve. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0. Emergency Management Director Tony Day intends to retire on June 30, 2025.

Road and Bridge Assistant Supervisor John Bargfrede submitted a request to extend 15.67 vacation hours for 90 days that was set to expire on May 13<sup>th</sup>. Becky Plattner asked for a motion to approve. Monte Fenner made a motion to approve. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Becky Plattner presented an agreement amendment with WSKF Architects in the amount of \$92,903. Due to different delays, the contract with WSKF will need to be extended to the end of this year. She asked for a motion to approve. Monte Fenner made a motion to approve. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Treasurer Jared Brewer announced that the County is due to submit an invitation to bid for the County bank accounts. It is a bid that is required to be let every 4 years.

Emergency Management Director Brad Hinz reported that there was no significant damage from the most recent storm. They were notified that the County needs to update its hazmat information, which happens every three years, and they are in the process of getting that update started.

Monte Fenner reported that the replacement tube for 200<sup>th</sup> Road is set to be delivered this week. The tube will replace the bridge that collapsed. It is an 84" x 50' tube, which should be more than enough to accommodate the water flow under 200<sup>th</sup> Road. The Commission reviewed roads in the Southeastern part and North Central part of the County after the recent storm and only saw minor damage. He stated he attended an MSDC meeting the previous week and will be attending the Sweet Springs ribbon cutting on Saturday May 24<sup>th</sup> at noon for their new laundromat.




Stephanie Gooden reported that she attended a Marshall Chamber of Commerce meeting on May 12<sup>th</sup>, a NACo (National Association of Counties) Rural Action Caucus and Agriculture Leadership meeting on May 13<sup>th</sup>, and a Missouri River Council consumer resources and mental health training on May 19<sup>th</sup>. The Commission met with MODOT's regional engineer Marsela Ward. She stated the information passed on to them about Hwy 240 is that the overlay asphalt has received less than positive results and part of that reason is because the base of the road is in poor shape. It is on the STIP plan, which is the five-year plan where MODOT projects go to be funded. It is

estimated to cost \$12,000,000. The entire road will have to be redone from top to base. The Commission will also be attending a meeting in Lafayette County on May 22<sup>nd</sup>. She announced that the Community Cleanup will be held on June 7<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm at the Saline County Fairgrounds, which will be happening on the same day as the Saline County BBQ but will not interfere with it. Household hazardous waste will be collected at the Marshall collection site. Items that will be collected at the Fairgrounds will be furniture, clothes, electronic e-scrap, bulk debris, two appliances per home, and tires will be accepted at a cost of \$2 per tire for the first four tires then \$5 for each additional tire. She thanked the Saline County Fair Association for the use of the Fairgrounds.

Becky Plattner asked that it be made a matter of the minutes that the County received the 2025 emergency management agreement from the City of Marshall on May 19<sup>th</sup> in the amount of \$26,093.34. The agreements are due in January every year. She also announced that they have received the final approval for the fire suppressant system at the Jail-Justice Center at a cost of approximately \$42,000. The Jail-Justice Center has also been approved for two sets of new doors for the front entrance and the painting of the front office area at a cost of \$82,504. The installation of the sprinkler system is expected to be completed next week, and the painting is expected to be completed in two weeks.

Monte Fenner gave a reminder that the Courthouse will be open on June 13<sup>th</sup>.

Becky Plattner asked for a motion to adjourn at 9:16 am. Monte Fenner made a motion to adjourn. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.
