Becky Plattner called the meeting to order at 11:00 am.

Becky Plattner asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the February 11, 2026 session. Monte Fenner made a motion to approve. Becky Plattner seconded. Motion carried 2-0-0.

Becky Plattner asked for a motion to approve a payment schedule. Monte Fenner made a motion to approve a payment schedule as presented. Becky Plattner seconded. Motion carried 2-0-0.

County Clerk Brittni Burton presented commission order #6753 in the amount of \$190,681.81 for a cash transfer of payroll, order #6754 in the amount of \$33,860.72 for 941 taxes, and order #6755 in the amount of \$4,150.27 for CERF .7% and elective savings. Monte Fenner made a motion to approve the commission orders as presented. Becky Plattner seconded. Motion carried 2-0-0.

Sheriff Daniel Kirchhoff submitted a request to hire Britlin Patschke for a part-time position in the Road Division as a reserve deputy. Her start date was February 16, 2026 and her rate of pay is \$22.63 per hour. Becky Plattner asked for a motion to approve the new hire. Monte Fenner made a motion to approve. Becky Plattner seconded. Motion carried 2-0-0.



Monte Fenner reported that the sewer project at the Junction is 86% completed, and that Government Day will be held on Friday March 6, 2026, starting at 9:00 am in the large courtroom.

Auditor Karlin Breshears reported that the 2026 budget is done and approved, and they are moving forward with the new year.

Becky Plattner reported that she attended a virtual meeting with Pioneer Trails Regional Planning Commission the previous day. She was appointed to represent the small cities and the Commission to work on a fee-based structure. In approximately two months they should have a proposed list of the dues and what will be provided to the small entities. She was proud to say that all but one city had paid their dues to Pioneer Trails. Being apart of Pioneer Trails helps them to get into Federal-level funding much easier since a lot of dollars are funneled through the Regional Planning Commissions.
