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Marriage License

Congratulations on your upcoming marriage!

Before you purchase your license there is some information you will need:

- **Set up your ceremony date with the minister or officiate that will be performing the wedding.**
- **Once your date is set you can purchase your license. We recommend that you come no sooner than the week of the wedding if possible. The license is only valid for 30 days and you will want plenty of time to get the license back to us.**
- **We issue marriage licenses Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. BY APPOINTMENT ONLY! Call 660-886-2677 to schedule an appointment.**

Requirements for marriage license:

- **Apply online at salinecountymo.gov, select the “Recorder” page, link to application at the bottom of the page.**
- **Both applicants must be present at appointment**
- **Both applicants will need to bring their driver’s license or a picture ID**
- **Both applicants will need to know their social security numbers**
- **If you have been married before, you need to know the date of the divorce or death of spouse**
- **Cost of the marriage license is \$62 – cash, check or credit card (\$2 convenience fee when paying with a card) This includes your \$9 certified copy.**

The marriage ceremony must be performed and license returned to the recorder’s office within 30 days of application

After the license has been signed and returned, a certified copy will be given to the applicant. Do not lose this copy, you will need it to apply for a new social security card and driver’s license.
